## Why should I get involved in research at the BRC?

We would like to work with you on our journey to new and better cancer treatment and care.

You know what it's like to receive treatment and the impact of side effects on your quality of life and so can provide valuable insight into a range of areas, including:

- Helping researchers understand what matters most to patients and their families.
- Challenging and shaping decisions about research.
- Helping researchers design research that is easier for patients to understand.

You would be helping to improve our research and will be offered training and support in doing so.

## What opportunities are available?

There are several ways you can get involved or be engaged with our research.

- You may simply want to be kept informed about events such as open days, training for involvement and research projects that may require your input.
- You may wish to contribute by email offering suggestions about improving our research documents, i.e. patient information sheets or leaflets.
- You might decide to become a member of the Patient and Carer Research Review Panel and through friendly meetings, comment on research proposals, and contribute to the formal review process for clinical trials.
- Or you may even decide to become more involved with the ongoing production of research.
